Agenda Item 1: Financial Report

Executive Summary	<ol> <li>We ended the year with \$65,701.04 among the three accounts (Operating, Money Market Reserve, and Savings). This also includes the \$15,000 we took out of the credit line in December and \$29,750.00 in 2023 prepaid annual pledges. Prepaid pledges are included in cash, but not 2022 revenues. They are held on the balance sheet in liabilities and are moved to revenues in January.</li> <li>We ended the year with a deficit of \$24,100, which is better than the projected budget deficit of \$57,826 and is due to several factors. Primary factors were an increase in actual pledge income of \$17,600; the extra 1.5% withdrawal from the endowment of \$17,000; \$15,000 draw from the credit line; offset by higher music expense of \$21,000; and, lower plate income of \$6,500.</li> <li>Since January 1, 2022, the endowment and trust declined by \$414,475, and \$52,067 respectively. Note that the decline in the endowment includes the draw during the year.</li> <li>The Treasurer recommends that the total draw of \$66,700 be submitted for approval of the Trustees in January and then the \$15,000 paid back to the credit line as soon as possible.</li> </ol>		
Discussion - Staff and Office Coverage	<ol> <li>Selma has indicated her ability to remain on staff through the end of May. Kurt will review associated costs and budget implications. One option will be an hourly rate with possible health care coverage. The Diocese has a policy on part-time staff requirements (threshold number of hours) for health care coverage. Kurt will report back to the Vestry.</li> <li>One item being considered is to limit office hours during the summer with minimal coverage, possibly by volunteers. If that approach works, then the part-time office position could begin September 1.</li> </ol>		

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Discussion	<ol> <li>A preliminary budget is set at \$270,000. For comparison purposes, following are annual/actual budgets for previous years: 2022 - \$252,603; 2021 - \$234,119; 2020 - \$296,989.</li> <li>Total pledging units and pledges are also up comparing 2021, 2022, and 2023 numbers as of 11 January for each respective year.</li> <li>A fully balanced budget would be approximately \$300,000.</li> </ol>
Motion	Marshall moved and Kelly seconded that the budget be approved. All voted in favor of the motion
Motion	Peggy moved and Kelly seconded that the Treasurer's recommendation (Item 4 above in Treasurer's Report) be approved. All voted in favor of the motion.
