

Summary: Vestry Meeting, Feb. 11, 2020

All but one of the members of the 2020 Vestry were present.

The function of the vestry is to articulate vision, ensure good ministry, and conduct business on time,

The Treasurer explained the 5 pages of the monthly report. Specifics: Clergy Transition Fund, Line of Credit at the bank, Pledge amounts, Endowment Fund, and Trust Fund were discussed as to their uses and budgeting. A 5 year graph of income and expenses was requested and promised.

The 2020 Budget was Approved.

Updating the valuation of church property is necessary for Diocesan policy, insurance and assessments.

Additional expenses for the "Rooted in Jesus" Conference in Atlanta were deemed an investment in mission and absorbed into the budget.

Vestry members signed up to count money during coffee hour by twos.

Vestry retreat was scheduled for March 28, from 8 AM to 3 PM.

Vestry chose the Junior Warden.

Reports were heard from the Newcomers Committee, the Stewardship Committee and the Social Committee. The Communications Committee is to be appointed. Rev. Kurt reported for the Children and Youth Committee. Finances, Facilities and Administration Committee reported that surveyors are preparing documents to comply with City requirements in the matter of demolishing the houses and repurposing the land. A painter was hired to repaint the church buildings. A parishioner requested documents pertaining to the plan to demolish the houses. Rev. Kurt expressed pleasure in his 5 year anniversary as Rector of St. Paul's. He will be serving as Chaplain to the Salt Lake City meeting of the Episcopal Church Executive Committee.
